

NORTH CAROLINA HOME INSPECTOR
LICENSE BOND

I _____ as principal, located at _____ and _____ (surety), a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of North Carolina and duly licensed to transact a surety business in the State of North Carolina as surety, are indebted and bound to the State of North Carolina in the sum of five thousand (\$5,000) dollars for which payment we bind ourselves and our legal representatives jointly and severally.

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, that whereas the principal has applied for a license under Chapter 143, Article 9F of the North Carolina General Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the principal shall faithfully perform all duties and comply with all laws pertaining to his license under Article 9F of Chapter 143 of the North Carolina General Statutes, then this obligation shall be null and void; otherwise, it shall be in force and effect.

A copy of the qualifying surety bond shall remain on file with the North Carolina Home Inspector Licensure Board.

This bond shall be open to successive claims up to the full amount of the bond.

The surety may terminate this bond upon notice in writing sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the North Carolina Home Inspector Licensure Board at 1202 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-1202. Termination shall not be effective until thirty (30) days after receipt of notice.
